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### PERMIT CONDITIONS

1. The permittee shall exercise this privilege subject to the supervision of the Superintendent, and shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations of the area.
2. Damages - The permittee shall pay the United States for any damage resulting from this use which would not reasonably be inherent in the use which the permittee is authorized to make of the land described in this permit.
3. Benefit - No Member of Congress shall be admitted to any share or part of this permit or to any benefit that may arise therefrom: but this provision shall not be construed to extend to this grant if made with a corporation for its general benefit.
4. Assignment - This permit may not be transferred or assigned without the consent of the Superintendent, in writing.
5. Revocation - This permit may be terminated upon breach of any of the conditions herein or at the discretion of the Superintendent.
6. The permittee is prohibited from giving false information; to do so will be considered a breach of conditions and be grounds for revocation [Re: 36 CFR 2.32(a)(4)].
7. Permittee will comply with applicable public health and sanitation standards and codes.
8. The permittee or a designated representative is required to (1) be in attendance at the Gravelly Point open grass field at all times while operating under this permit, (2) to carry a copy of this permit on the premises at all times, and (3) is held responsible for full compliance with the conditions of this permit by all participants. **Please Note** - The permittee is responsible for providing each designated representative with a copy of this permit.
9. **Goal post height restriction** – The goal post height must not exceed 40 feet. The goal post height is due to aviation safety concerns for aircraft overlying the park area off the approach end of Runway 19 at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport.

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10. **Revocation** -This permit may be terminated upon the violation of any of the permit conditions or at the discretion of the Superintendent, George Washington Memorial Parkway or designated representative.
11. The permittee will comply with all instructions issued by the U.S. Park Police or other representative (s) of the Superintendent, George Washington Memorial Parkway.
12. **The possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.**
13. **Dogs must be on leashes at all times.**
14. **No playing is permitted during rain or snow and if there are visible signs of standing water or snow on the field.**
15. The permittee shall require all participants to exercise stringent safety precautions.
16. The permittee agrees to indemnify the United States and the National Park Service for any and all claims that may arise from any participant engaged in the activity specified in this permit. **Please Note** - Further, the permittee is required to inform all participants that the open park area described in this permit is maintained solely as an open grassy field and not a leveled, improved area which is designed for organized athletic competitions.
17. No exclusive use of the area is permitted. The area must remain open to the general public at all times.
18. Prior to each use of the area under this permit, the permittee or a designated representative is required to carefully inspect the specific area to be used for any hazardous conditions. All activities and use of the field authorized by this permit must be suspended until any unsafe conditions can be corrected. The permittee is required to immediately notify the permit coordinator, See Condition 32, of any hazardous conditions and to suspend use of the field.

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19. The permittee shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations of the area.
20. The solicitation, exchange, collection, or receiving of money in the form of fees, dues, donations, or any other means while on park property is prohibited.
21. This sports activity may take place no closer than 20 feet to the Mount Vernon Trail and no closer than 100 feet to any roadway.
22. **Parking - Due to the limited number of parking spaces in this congested area, the permittee is required to direct participants to car pool or use other means of transportation insofar as possible.**
23. **No driving and parking is permitted on any grass areas WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE VEHICLES DESIGNATED IN CONDITIONS 24 AND 25.**
24. **Parking is permitted only in the designated parking area, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF ONE VEHICLE FOR USE IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY, which may park on the grass near the playing field. No designated parking spaces may be reserved and all parking spaces must remain open and available on a strictly first come, first use basis.**
25. **Vehicles delivering equipment are permitted to drive on the service road through the grass area in order to deliver and pick-up equipment but are required to park in the designated parking area.**
26. The posting and/or display of any type of banners, signs, logos, and commercial advertising is prohibited.
27. Balloons and glass bottles are prohibited.

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28. The leagues, clubs, or teams using United States property for games must be open organizations. Any exclusion, refusal, or discrimination of or against any individual from participation in league activities because of race, gender, age, or affiliation shall be grounds for actions to revoke this permit.
29. **The area must be left in substantially the same condition as prior to the activities authorized. All litter must be placed inside the park trash containers.**
30. **Damages** – The permittee shall pay the United States for any damage resulting from this use which would not reasonably be inherent in the use which the permittee is authorized to make of the land described in this permit.
31. **Assignment** - This permit may not be transferred or assigned without the consent in writing of the Superintendent, George Washington Memorial Parkway.
